

YORKSHIRE VILLAGE “PARKING POLICY”

Parking Enforcement LLC currently manages and provides parking enforcement for all of the Yorkshire Village parking areas. Vehicles should park in an orderly fashion – vehicles should not block the dumpsters, block other vehicles, park in no parking zones, park in main drive lanes or drive ways, park in front of garages, on sidewalks or take more than one parking space. All vehicles on the property must have a current license and it must be displayed on the outside of the vehicle. Vehicles may not be stored on the property. Vehicles must move to a different location every ten days or they will be removed from the property. Vehicles found in violation of the “Parking Policy” **will always be booted or towed** and the appropriate fee must be paid before the vehicle will be released. All rules currently contained in the Yorkshire Village Resident Manual and Rules and Regulations handbook apply and will be strictly enforced.

It is the responsibility of residents to inform their guests of the “Parking Policy”.

Booting Hours: 9:00 pm to 7:00 am – 7 Days a Week

Parking Enforcement LLCs Fee Schedule

Resident / Non-Resident	\$75.00* minimum
Fee increases	\$25.00 per 24-hour period boot is on the vehicle after the first 24 hours.
Towing:	Rate charged by towing company

** Other fees may also apply (i.e., time, vandalism, and/or theft); Vehicles that are towed will pay whatever fee is charged by the towing company. Fees are subject to change without notice. Violators are liable for damages to tire locking mechanisms. Management is not responsible for damage to vehicles or property of any kind.*
