SPRINKLERS

We have had a lot of maintenance done on sprinklers this year including replacing the backflow on the west side of the property and replacing the system clocks. Please be sure to keep an eye out for areas that might be having issues and let us know so that they can be repaired quickly.

We also ask that parents be attentive to your children and do not allow them to play on or open sprinkler boxes/green boxes or mess with sprinkler heads. Pet owners should also keep an eye on pets to ensure they do not chew on sprinkler heads.

HOME MAINTENANCE TIPS

Extreme heat and cold temperatures (like we have here in Cache Valley) can have a harsh effect on door frames and doors.

When repainting and maintaining
the back door of your unit
and inside of your garage
entrance, we recommend
doing a thorough job re
moving old paint and be
sure to caulk around the

edges to ensure waterproofing.

A little extra time and effort now will save you a lot of money in the long run!
