MAINTENANCE

Sometimes out of sight out of mind can have long-term consequences. Did you know that your HOA is NOT responsible to maintain the molding around your doors and windows? Did you know that neglecting to ensure your molding is weatherproofed can have expensive long-term consequences? Each year tenants/occupants are reminded to paint and maintain their exterior molding. Not maintaining this part of your home could result in warping and damage to your doors, or allow for water to get into your walls and result in illness-causing mold. You should be evaluating your exterior molding no less than once per year.

Below are low-cost simple steps to help ensure that you are not stuck with an expensive bill down the road.

- Use paint remover, wire brush, and metal scraper to remove old and flaking paint
- 2. Purchase an exterior semi-gloss paint in Dover White (the approved HOA color)
- 3. An oil-based paint resistant to mold would be best
- 4. Use a good wood filler to repair any large gaps or cracks in the molding
- 5. Be sure to sand it smooth

- Caulk with paintable calking where the molding meets the door trim
- 7. Paint molding and allow to dry completely
- 8. Using a good clear or colorcoordinated silicone caulk, caulk where the molding meets the house
- Relax with peace of mind, knowing your home is secure from the elements
