WHEREAS, "Declaration" is the <u>Master Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions for Providence Gateway;</u> and "Association" is the <u>Providence Gateway Master Association;</u> and "Board" is the Board of Directors for the Association; and

WHEREAS, Article 5 Section 9 of the Declaration states that the Master Association shall have the authority to promulgate and enforce Rules for the regulation and operation of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to set forth a rules pertaining to trash and recycling receptacles; and

WHEREAS, this resolution shall be kept in the Association's records and may be modified from time to time; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent that is rule shall be applicable to all homes; and

WHERAS, this resolution shall remain in effect until otherwise rescinded, modified, or amended by the Board; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the following policy is hereby adopted by the Board of Directors:

Trash and recycling receptacles shall be properly stored at all times except for scheduled collection. Properly stored shall mean that the receptacle is placed in the garage or directly next to the garage. Receptacles may be positioned on street curb the evening before pickup so long as the lid of the receptacle is fully closed so as not to attract animals or lose debris out of can. Receptacles shall be returned to the properly stored location by the end of collection day. Any variances to this policy must be approved in advance by the Board in writing.
